



Dhyan Vimal calls upon all humanity to be a Friend to Mankind.

Now, we can all participate to make this planet we live in a better place for everyone, by a simple shift in consciousness. Friends to Mankind, founded by Dhyan Vimal, is an action towards creating an awareness where people can live in peace by simply awakening and choosing to be a Friend to Mankind. He added that just as the butterfly seeks nectar for its own survival, it participates in the survival of the whole too, through cross-pollination. Friends to Mankind is to awaken us to see that as we seek for our own survival, we recognize that we are participating in the universe too.

Asked about the vision of Friends to Mankind, Dhyan Vimal outlined them in three main points.

1. To call upon all humanity to establish a platform on this earth, in which all of us can live in peace, governed by the power of friendship and interdependency.
2. To support and nourish all individuals and organizations, working towards the betterment of humanity at large.
3. To create an education system that supports life and to embed the understanding that all success that is experienced or achieved, must be a success for humanity at large.
